

II. Sink cut-out template

Use the template provided with the sink to create the cut-out.

When you create the cut-out, it is important that you ensure the corners are rounded, as shown in the template, and not square.



III. Assembly and installation


Note: Number in brackets refer to part groups listed in the parts table.

- 1. Attach drain assembly (1) to sink (2):
 - a. Set top gasket and drain plate top inside sink.



b. Hold the drain plate bottom in place and insert the drain pin connector. Tighten in place using a coin or a washer. Center and adjust as needed.






2. Attach faucet (3). Ensure gasket is directly under faucet base.




3. Attach base for the soap dispenser (4).



- Install sink (2) in cut-out. Note: Sink has been removed for these 4. pictures.
 - Place sink in cut-out. a.
 - Insert the screws in the hold-down clamps. b.



Slide the clamps in place under the sink.



Use a total of 8 hold-down clamps.



- d. Tighten the clamps with a standard screwdriver.
- 5. Connect water line to the faucet. Depending on your water line, you may need an adaptor. The faucet requires a $\frac{1}{2}$ " connecter.



Note: An adaptor is not included with your sink. You will need to provide one for the size of your water line connection.

6. Attach drain tube (5) to drain.



Attach trap (6) to drain. 7.



Attach drain elbow (7). 8.



9. Attach the soap dispenser bottle under the sink.



10. Insert the straw in the dispenser head.



11. Place soap dispenser head in dispenser base.



Note: You can add liquid soap to the dispenser by pouring it directly into the dispenser base after the bottle has been attached.
